**::General Notification and Information Regarding the Admission
to various Undergraduate Courses for the Academic Session
2021-2022 at Government General Degree College, Lalgarh::**

- Admission process for all undergraduate courses under the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) at GGDC, Lalgarh (under the affiliation of the Vidyasagar University) will start from 2nd August (Monday), 2021 as per the scheduled mentioned in this notification.
- Applicants willing to take admission in this college are advised to visit the College Website www.lalgarhgovtcollege.org and <http://admission.lalgarhgovtcollege.org> on a regular basis.
- All applicants must register through the Government General Degree College Lalgarh online admissions portal <http://admission.lalgarhgovtcollege.org>
- A valid and specific Mobile Number and E-mail ID are mandatory for filling up the online registration/admission form. Candidates are strictly instructed to provide their own / parents' mobile number and **their own email ID** while filling up the online registration/admission form.
- All communication will be done through this mobile number and email id already provided. Once taken admission, this mobile number and email ID cannot be changed under any circumstances during the entire course of study at this College.
- All undergraduate admissions for 2021 - 22 will be administered only through the admission portal mentioned above.

- **There is no provision for any kind offline admission in any of the available courses.**
- **Only eligible applicants who have registered online through the admissions portal <http://admission.lalgarhgovtcollege.org/> will be considered for admission.**
- **The online admission process would be carried out on the basis of merit points. Prospective and selected students would be called for virtual counseling or verification of documents during/after the process of admission. **Physical presence is strictly prohibited allowed at the college for admission/counseling/verification.****
- **Verification of documents will be done only when the students report for classes in due course of time. Admission will be cancelled if the documents are found incorrect and not in conformity with the declaration in the submitted forms through online mode prior to provisional admission. This is according to the rule of the Government of West Bengal and the Vidyasagar University.**
- **Admission to any course of the college is provisional and is subject to the final approval of the Vidyasagar University.**
- **Anti-ragging declaration mandate as directed by the UGC is to be furnished online by every student and his/her guardian after admission.**
- **Caste Certificates (wherever applicable) issued only by appropriate authority will be considered valid and acceptable. Percentage of reservation to each reserved category follows the G.O. No. 267-Edn (U/1U-89/13 dated 04.03.14) of Government of West Bengal, Higher Education Department.**
- **The candidates who have taken admission elsewhere are allowed to take admission to this college provisionally. However, transfer certificate or admission cancellation statement from the previous institution must be submitted within the stipulated time as scheduled by the College. Admission to this college will be cancelled if they fail to do so.**
- **Candidates must fulfill 90% of attendance within first ten (10) days of commencement of their classes. Failing which, their admission will be treated as cancelled. Only special cases will be considered in this matter provided the students inform the college authority in advance in written document.**

Eligibility Criteria

- Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council listed below in the year (2021/2020/2019) are eligible to apply.
- Candidate who have passed in 05(Five)/ 04(Four) (whichever is applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject.
- For honours courses the candidates must have passed with at least 45% marks in Aggregate** or 50% marks in subjects or related subjects in the qualifying examination.

2. Register yourself by visiting the said website; get your specific User name and Password through SMS / E-mail
3. Enter in your Account/Login using that Username and Password
4. Click on 'Apply Now' tab.

 - Step 2: Form Fill-up (Academic Details)

 - Step 3: Form Fill-up (Upload Documents) (**only .jpeg* format within 200 KB**)
 - ⊙ Upload Passport Size Photograph (within 200KB).
 - ⊙ Upload Your Signature (within 200KB).
 - ⊙ Upload Your 10+2 Original Marksheet (within 200KB).
 - ⊙ Upload Your Original Caste Certificate (within 200KB), if applicable.
 - ⊙ Upload Your Original PWD Certificate (within 200KB), if any.
 - Step 4: Fill up the subjects for which you want to apply.
 - Step 5: Please recheck, accept terms and condition and submit it. No edit is allowed after submission.
6. Take the print out of the submitted form, paste the uploaded photograph, sign in appropriate places and keep it with you till physical verification of the documents after admission.

Aggregate is calculated by the sum of the highest five marks in different subjects in 10+2 examination.

1. If the total Marks of any Board or Council other than the West Bengal Council Higher Secondary Education is less or more than 500, then the total number obtained by the candidates of that Board or Council will be converted to 500.

2. Marks secured by WBCHSE candidates in Environmental Studies which is a compulsory subject will not be counted for calculating Aggregate# and merit score.

3. Admission will be conducted strictly on the basis of merit. The subject wise merit list will be prepared based on 'merit points' for all categories of students.

4. *The number obtained in the subject or in the first language which is highest, will be considered in the merit point calculation.
